

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for October, 2014 with a total of 34 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

Fire Department: No one was present. A report was turned in with three fire calls in Pulaski, one in New Brighton and five in Daugherty Township.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for October will be e-mailed to the Supervisors and mailed to Mr. Mooney. He reported that letters were sent to all the landlords and they are supposed to schedule inspections by November 28.

Recreation Commission: Mr. McCullough was not present. Mr. Albanese said that a Casino trip is being planned for November 14th.
