

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
November 11, 2019**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Chief Walton, Don Chapman, Peggy Griffith, Code Enforcement Office, Engineer Shawn Wingrove, William Thomas and Attorney Joseph M. Budicak.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of the October 14, 2019 regular meeting and the Budget Meeting of October 21, 2019. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

Engineer Shawn Wingrove was present to address the MS4 project. He explained what needs to be done. He submitted a sample ordinance we need to adopt for fees for the MSR project. Attorney Budicak will look it over before we advertise.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

William Thomas addressed the board on several issues. He asked about the property of the old service station. The building is crumbling and the area needs cleaned up. Mrs. Griffith stated that someone purchased the property and plan to remodel and put in offices. He also stated that there are big trailer trucks parking on the property. The trucks hinder the view of oncoming traffic and it is just a matter of time that there will be an accident there. Next, he inquired about the property of the duplex on 46th Street. Furniture has been out at the curb for three weeks now. He asked if the supervisors couldn't possibly adopt an ordinance in "reference to the conditions of property". It is being done elsewhere and we need to clean up this township. Mr. Hage said that would certainly be a consideration for the board to investigate. The final question was about burning in June, July and August. He was told that during June, July and August there can be recreational fires. Camp fires, picnics and no garbage, leaves, papers, etc.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in October cutting grass, weed whacking, cleaning catch basin tops, hauling millings, working on the leaf machine, litter patrol and picking up leaves.
