

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
November 12, 2018**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Police Chief Walton, Alan Hickey, Tina Kruiise, Margie Placinik and Attorney Joseph M. Budicak.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2018 meeting. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Ms. Margie Placinik of 3410 – 45th Street was present to register a complaint about the trash on 45th Street. It is never removed and rats and wild animals are getting in it now. Mrs. Griffith stated that the residents have been cited. Also, she inquired about the dog on 45th Street that is attacking other dogs and is left out in the rain, freezing temperatures, etc. Chief Walton stated that the Humane Society has been contacted.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey, Fire Chief, was present and he reported two fire calls in Pulaski Township and six in Daugherty Township for October, 2018. The report will be put on file.

Code Enforcement and Zoning Officer: Mrs. Griffith was present. Her report will be put on file. She asked the supervisors if a dumpster could be ordered to clean up trash on 45th Street. It will be discussed under new business.

Recreation: Mr. Cracker was not present. There was no report.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in October with cutting grass and weed whacking, cleaning equipment, picking up branches, picking up leaves, putting millings on 52nd Street, paving on 52nd Street, 37th Avenue and 38th Avenue and back filling paved areas.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the contract with the Beaver County Humane Society for the year 2019 at the rate of \$195.00 per month. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to have the Borough of New Brighton continue as Code Enforcement/Zoning for 2019 at the rate of \$500.00 per month. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to give Mrs. Griffith permission to get a dumpster for the property on 3401 A,B,C 45th Street. The cost will be filed as a lien against the property. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.
