COMMITTEE REPORTS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Kimberly Keener Johnson to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement of Cooperation with Daugherty Township and Borough of New Brighton for a Regional Emergency Management Agency covering the rules for duties of EMA, Finances, Insurance, Contributions, and effective dates. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Resolution #396 Prohibiting the location of a Category 4 Licensed Facility (Mini Casino) within the Township. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.
