

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for November, 2014 with a total of 31 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

**Fire Department:** Alan Hickey was present and reported there seven fire calls with four in Pulaski and three in Daugherty Township. He report will be put on file.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for November will be put on file. He stated that rental inspections have been scheduled for all but four landlords.

**Recreation Commission:** Mr. McCullough was present. He had nothing to report because there were enough committee members in attendance to conduct a meeting.

**Roads:** Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been with collecting leaves and branches, working on the leaf machine, salting and snow removal. The gutters were fixed on the garage and cleaned. A new furnace will be installed tomorrow in the garage.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Attorney Budicak stated he still hasn't heard from the Attorney on the case about the truck. A new attorney has been assigned to the case and he is hoping that he will have some more information by the next meeting.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to appoint Laurie Dishler of 3405 – 45<sup>th</sup> Street as auditor for the Township. Her term expires in 2015. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Resolution #377 - Second Class Tax Levy setting the Budgets for 2015. The General Fund Budget is \$334,150, Revenue is \$364,717 and State Aid is \$98,011 (Revenue) and \$86,000 for Expenditures. There will be no increase in taxes. The millage is 13. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to appoint the members of the Zoning Hearing Board as follows: Mr. Joseph Helbling, 6 years; Mrs. Elaine Hildebrand, 4 years and William Thomas, 2 years. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to appoint the members of the Planning Commission as follows: Thomas Worst, 6 years; Deborah Hickman, 4 years and George Muska, two years. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Mr. McCullough told Chief Van Fossan about someone trying to get into houses on 46<sup>th</sup> Street and that maybe the police could keep an eye out. He was told to call the police when they see anything suspicious. He has filed suit against Unis Demolition about the property on 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
