

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. Her report will be put on file.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was not in attendance.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy clean up of the debris from the Storm, hauling millings on 33rd Avenue and helping with the paving on 33rd Avenue, Picking up leaves and Branches, Salt the Roads and Plowing Snow.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak stated that the trial for the truck should be coming up in the middle of next month.. He has also filed law suits in the Court House with the Sheriff's Department on our problem properties.

Attorney Budicak was asked about the filing of the vacating of streets in the Assessment Office and he informed the Board that wasn't necessary because he filed it in the Clerk of Courts Office. He will double check this week to be sure it isn't necessary.

Mr. Margetic brought the subject of the Cemetery Bridge and the possibility of closing it. It costs over two thousand dollars every year for an inspection and the state is constantly changing the position of posting of the signs.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. William Thomas was present and expressed his appreciation to the Supervisors about the paving of 33rd Avenue. He stated that Mike Zachodni did an excellent job and when the paving was done he finished the berms and did a great job. The last time it rained he did not have a pond. He is a very happy camper going into the Holiday Season.

Mrs. Cain wanted to thank the supervisors for the great job they do for the Township.

Mr. McCullough commended the supervisors and the secretary for the excellent job they do for the township. Mr. McCullough was checking into the property on 32nd Avenue and said they want too much money for the property. Attorney Budicak stated that he would talk to Mr. Coleman in the Assessment Office and explain to him the condition of the property and see what could be done.
