

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
December 9, 2019**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Chief Walton, Don Chapman, Peggy Griffith, Code Enforcement Office, William Thomas, Mark P. Wagle, Connie Wagle, Ralph Flara, and Attorney Joseph M. Budicak.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of the November 11, 2019 regular meeting and the Budget Meeting of October 21, 2019. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Walton was present. A report for November, 2019 was given to the supervisors with 36 calls. He had nothing more to add.

Fire Department: Donald Chapman, Assistant Fire Chief, was present and he reported two fire calls in Pulaski Township and two in Daugherty Township for November, 2019. The report will be put on file.

Code Enforcement and Zoning Officer: Mrs. Griffith was present. Her report will be put on file. She had the paper for the Township to sign in reference to the sub-division of the property for Peter and Eleanor Pezzella. – 4104 Marion Hill Road. Mrs. Griffith reported a vacant house on 47th Street has been condemned and there are animals in the house. The Humane Society is involved.

Recreation: Mr. Cracker was not present. A report was not received.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in November cutting grass, weed whacking, cleaning catch basin tops, hauling millings, working on the leaf machine, litter patrol and picking up leaves.

Mr. Hage questioned the invoices for roads for the township from the Borough of New Brighton. The bid was for \$38,000.12 and the township received invoices totaling \$60,434.23. Only \$38,000.12 was approved and the township wants to know who okayed the additional work and what it was for. Attorney Budicak advised them that they should check and get a written report and all the work and who okayed it.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to table hiring a new secretary for the township until all the candidates can be interviewed. The secretary was instructed to set up interviews for December 17, 2019. The supervisors can decide at the December 30, 2019. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to join New Brighton Borough to do another newsletter in 2020 to the citizens of New Brighton, Daugherty

Township, Pulaski Township and Fallston Borough. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruise, yes. The motion was carried.
