He said it seems when someone calls the police all of a sudden they quit before the police gets there. He was advised to keep a daily log of what goes on and when, the time and calls made to the police. If necessary and the police file a report, Mr. Krechowski would need to go to court and that way he would have a definite record of what is going on. Mr. Margetic said he will get in touch with the Code Enforcement Officer about the situation.
