A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni rescind the motion to accept the contract with the Beaver County Humane Society for the year 2019 at the rate of \$195.00 per month. The Humane Society will be contacted about the language of the agreement. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes, Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.
