

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the November 14, 2011 meeting and Budget Meeting, November 21, 2011. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for November with a total of 46 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report. Mr. Sheets asked what can be done about the people coming to the stop sign on 43<sup>rd</sup> Street and 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The people headed for New Brighton don't stop. The Chief said he would check into the matter. Mr. Bible inquired as to where a person is to stop when they get to the top of the hill at 13<sup>th</sup> Street. Chief VanFossan said that you have to stop at the stop sign (State Road) and then again before proceeding.

**Fire Department:** Alan Hickey Assistant Fire Chief gave the Chairman a report that there was four fire calls last month. All were in Daugherty. He wasn't at the meeting because they had training.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was not present. He had given a report to the chairman stating that he had ten complaints, tagged eight cars, had one car towed and issued two building permits.

**Recreation:** Mr. Barr was in attendance. Mr. Barr reported that the work on Memorial Field behind the Middle School has stopped for the winter. They will finish in the spring. Mr. Barr informed the Supervisors that he will not be serving on the Recreation Commission after the end of this year. He is willing to serve as an alternate.

**Roads:** Mr. Mooney reported that Mike has been busy picking up leaves and branches, cleaning catch basins and working on the equipment..

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to pay \$195.00 to John Clay for reimbursement for Building Code Official. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Mr. Dick West was present to express concern about the property at 3906 - 39<sup>th</sup> Street, New Brighton. The people living in the trailer have four children and are raising pit bulls. They do not have a garbage collector. They burn everything – garbage, plastic, etc. They have no control over their kids. They are damaging the neighbors property. They are asking that the Code Enforcement Officer do something about the situation.

Mrs. Gallagher of 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue was present in reference to a water problem she is having because of the water runoff on 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue. She said she has spent thousands of dollars trying to keep her place dry. She has to pay over \$5,000 again this week for another sump pump. Mr. Margetic said that he will be checking into the matter.

Mr. Muska inquired as to why his permit for a fence is \$119.00. Mr. Clay added \$40.00 for zoning and he already had his place surveyed. Mr. Margetic and Mr. Hage said he doesn't have to pay the \$40.00.

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Mr. Margetic announced that there will not be a community clean-up day next year. The money is needed for doing roads, which is more important.
