

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NUMBER #249**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING, IN PART, ORDINANCE NUMBER 110 AS ADOPTED BY THE TOWNSHIP ON FEBRUARY 14, 1955 AND AS REVISED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER A220 ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2001, THE LATER BEING A CODIFICATION OF THE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE. SAID ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A PER CAPITA TAX ON RESIDENCE OVER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS OF AGE RESIDING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP; SAID AMENDMENT CHANGING THE PARAGRAPH.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township of Pulaski, by and through the Supervisors of the same, does hereby enact, ordain and establish the following Amendment to the abovementioned Ordinance:

SECTION I – Section 24-505(2) (A), Enforcement and Remedies is hereby amended as follows by adding the following to the existing Section 24-505(2) (A):

In addition to the aforementioned fines and/or penalties and any other penalties permissible by law, any such person, partnership, corporation shall also pay the ten percent (10%) penalty on the unpaid taxable amount.

SECTION II – In all other respects this Ordinance shall remain unchanged and in effect and any and all prior Ordinances not in conformity with the Amendment are hereby rescinded to the extent that they are not in conformity with the same.
