ORDINANCE #251

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI, BEAVER COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING, IN PART, CHAPTER 7 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF PULASKI TOWNSHIP, ALSO ORIGINALLY DESIGNATED AS ORDINANCE NUMBER 209 OF PULASKI TOWNSHIP, THE SAME DEALING WITH OUTDOOR BURNING.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township of Pulaski, by and through the Supervisors of the same, does hereby enact, ordain and establish the following Amendment to the aforementioned ordinance:

SECTION I – Section 7-102 is hereby supplemented by the following language to be added to the end of the same:

Notwithstanding the foregoing limitations, burning of a recreational fire shall be permitted in June, July and August of each year including Sunday and Monday.

A recreational fire is an outdoor fire, with burning materials other than rubbish or trash and not contained in an incinerator. The receptacle for such fire shall have a total field area of four feet (48") or less in diameter and be used for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking, warmth or similar purposes.

SECTION II – In all other respects the aforementioned Ordinance shall remain unchanged and in effect and any and all prior Ordinances not in conformity with this Amendment are hereby rescinded to the extent that they are not in conformity with the same.
