**RESOLUTION #352**

**THIS RESOLUTION BY THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IS FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE DEDICATION OF A ROADWAY FOR PUBLIC USE.**

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS:** a private roadway known as Forty-ninth Street (formerly Daugherty Street) has been offered for dedication for public use by certain Grantors; specifically Mark Kehoe, Natalia Blinn, Charles F. Nail and Lou Ann Nail, his wife; and

**WHEREAS:** said Pulaski Township is willing to accept said offer of dedication for said roadway for public use.

**NOW THEREFORE,** It is hereby resolved by the Township Supervisors of Pulaski Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. That the roadway known as Forty-ninth Street (formerly known as Daugherty Street), the same being approximately forty (40) feet in width from Fortieth Avenue in said Township a distance of approximately three hundred (300) feet to the boundary between Daugherty Township and said Pulaski Township is currently a private roadway.
2. That the same has been offered for dedication by deed of Mark Kehoe, Natalia Blinn, Charles F. Nail and Lou Ann Nail, his wife, recorded prior hereto in the Beaver County Recorder of Deeds Office.
3. Be it resolved by the Township Supervisors that they accept said dedication of Forty-ninth Street as a public roadway.
