 6. N. 34th Avenue to Sunflower Road – tar & chip

Hoping to Piggyback with New Brighton.


May consider more tar and chipping

Should be under budget

- Truck: We need to start looking into someone to Piggyback with to purchase a new truck, the 2003 truck is starting to cost money for a lot of repairs. We go through COG for this.
- Clean up day: Connie has made calls to Aiken, Brunner, Young, Valley for the cost for curb side pick in the township. We need as flat rate.
- Comprehensive Plan: Laura Ludwig will be at meeting to explain about zoning. We need to consider this at the April meeting so it may be adopted at our May meeting. Supervisors concerned it will not benefit Pulaski as it should. Will listen to her and will discuss.
- 37th Street/Rochester Road, Ralph had someone from Penn Dot come out to look at the problem of the water running down the hill onto Rochester Road. The Penn Dot worker did find a leak at the water valve, so Ralph called the water authority, and the leak was fixed. However, there is still water running down the hill onto Sunflower Road. Penn Dot suggested running pipe down onto Rochester Road and then run to in front of George Hage house.
