- Paving was discussed. The information was provided, and we will piggyback with New Brighton this year. The following roads will be done:
 - 30th Street – patch and tar & chip
 - 41st Street – (bend) tar & chip
 - N. 33rd – patch and tar & chip
 - 41st Avenue – patch and tar & chip
- Mr. Wagle announce the salt order did arrive. We will need another order to fulfill the amount we needed to order.
- Mr. Zachodni suggested hiring a part time person which would be seasonal, must be over 18 years old and have valid drivers license. The position would NOT include benefits, NO insurance, NO PTO. This would help Mike with cleaning some of the drains out. Connie will compose an ad for next meeting.
- Mr. Flara would like to get some volunteers possibly kids this summer to paint the fire hydrants. He will check with Chief Walton and check with BF Water Authority.
- Mr. Flara would like to get something done with the catch basin behind his house, it is filled to the stop with rocks/debris- needs cleaned out.
- In regard to the new Planning Commission If anyone comes to the office and wants copies of the plan or copies of the meeting minutes. There would be a charge and it would need prepaid, and they would need to get the whole article printed not just a page.
