Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Peggy Griffith was present to give report. The planning commission held their meeting last month and changed the business sign size. The Commissioners are to propose Municipalities to vote for acceptance at the April 9, 2023 meeting. The report will be placed on file in the office.
