

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP**  
**REGULAR MEETING**

April 8, 2024

The Pulaski Township Supervisors held their monthly meeting on Monday, April 8, 2024 in the Pulaski Township Firehall, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA 15066. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mr. Casey Zachodni, Chairman. Mr. Zachodni led the pledge to the flag.

After the most recent storm the fire department pumped out the neighbor's basement and the hose were running through her yard when there was a drain nearby the hose could have been placed in or pump water into the resident's yard that they are pumping the water out of the basement. Ms. Pavlinich would also like to know if there was any decision made regarding the zoning meeting a few weeks ago. Mr. Zachodni and Mrs. Griffith assured her the vote will be done soon. Ms. Pavlinich also added that she would like to see the zoning committee introduce themselves before the meeting, as many do not know the names of the residents on the zoning committee. Mr. Zachodni stated that he will pass this information on to the zoning committee. Mr. Gary Pavlinich is also addressing the issue with the fire department pumping water from the neighbor's basement with hose pumping water into his front yard washing away his mulch. He would like to know who is going to pay for the replacement of his mulch? Mr. Zachodni apologized for the incident of the water being pumped into his yard and he will address this with the fire department. Mr. Chapman from the fire department was present to hear this as well.
